### \*INVITATION TO CONFESSON

The prophet Amos asked those who prayed for God to come near saying, "Why do you want the day of the Lord? ... Is not the day of the Lord darkness not light?" His words are a warning reminding us that too often we pray for God's judgement on the sins of others and forget the harm that we have done. He calls all of us to repentance and transformation so that justice can roll

down like water and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.  
Let us pray...

\***PRAYER OF CONFESSION (*Unison*)**

**Sheltering God, we confess that our judgement often becomes clouded by our own willfulness: We speak when we should listen and our words harm those around us. We act out of fear instead of faith and drive a wedge between us and our neighbors. We place our trust in human ideologies and leaders instead of the Son of Man who came to seek and save the lost. Destroy, O God, the wisdom of this world! Drown out the voices of gossip, false prophets, and our own selfish desire and replace it with the foolishness of the cross. Make your face shine upon us so that we can see our faults and be renewed by your mercy and love. Reform us so that we all might be presented faultless on the day of Christ. Amen.**

*Matthew 17:1-9*

<sup>1</sup> Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain, by themselves. <sup>2</sup> And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became bright as light. <sup>3</sup> Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him. <sup>4</sup> Then Peter said to Jesus, “Lord, it is good for us to be here; if you wish, I will set up three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” <sup>5</sup> While he was still speaking, suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, “This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!” <sup>6</sup> When the disciples heard this, they fell to the ground and were overcome by fear. <sup>7</sup> But Jesus came and touched them, saying, “Get up and do not be afraid.” <sup>8</sup> And when they raised their eyes, they saw no one except Jesus himself alone.

<sup>9</sup> As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus ordered them, “Tell no one about the vision until after the Son of Man has been raised from the dead.”

#### THE OLD TESTAMENT READING

*Exodus 34:29-35*

<sup>29</sup> Moses came down from Mount Sinai. As he came down from the mountain with the two tablets of the covenant in his hand, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God. <sup>30</sup> When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, the skin of his face was shining, and they were afraid to come near him. <sup>31</sup> But Moses called to them, and Aaron and all the leaders of the congregation returned to him, and Moses

spoke with them.<sup>32</sup> Afterward all the Israelites came near, and he gave them in commandment all that the Lord had spoken with him on Mount Sinai.<sup>33</sup> When Moses had finished speaking with them, he put a veil on his face,<sup>34</sup> but whenever Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he would take the veil off until he came out, and when he came out and told the Israelites what he had been commanded,<sup>35</sup> the Israelites would see the face of Moses, that the skin of his face was shining, and Moses would put the veil on his face again until he went in to speak with him.
